Declaration of Compliance

Products covered by this declaration:

JP-E410, 2410E and TH-410, S2410

JP-E430, 3430E and TH-430, S3430

The above-mentioned products comply compositionally with the requirements of the Framework Regulation: Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, as amended.

The above-mentioned products also comply compositionally with the requirements of the ANZFCS, as amended. This requires that inks used for egg-stamping be assessed as “food safe” or “food grade”. All substances used in the above-mentioned products have been assessed by an independent third-party laboratory and confirmed as authorized by a competent authority.

These products are produced in compliance with Commission Regulation (EC) No 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

These products are manufactured only with substances that are listed in Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 of 14 January 2011 on plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food; and additionally, with colors and a quote for marking which complies with the requirements of Regulation (EC) No 1333/2008, Article 17: Uses of colours for markings and are listed in ANZFSC Schedule 15 – substances that may be used as food additives, as amended.

Considering the above, the compositions also comply with the requirements of United Kingdom Law considering the exit from the EU, specifically:

Information about the compliance of substances used that are subject to any restriction or specification:

The colors used for marking complies with the specification listed in Regulation EU 231/2012 laying down specifications for food additives listed in Annex II and III to Regulation (EC) No 1333/2008.

All other substances are listed in Annex I (the Union List) of Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 without restrictions.

Based on the above and the results of a Confidential Regulatory Report from an independent third party laboratory (Report No IWTN/W000017308RL001) we can state that, presuming appropriate processing on the part of the customer, the above mentioned products may be used safely for marking the shell of raw/unprocessed eggs for the purpose of traceability and identification of eggs in cross border (EU) sales in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) No 1308/2013 and within the United Kingdom in accordance with the relevant SI and Retained EU Legislation and the Australia and New Zealand areas.
